Target Group and Prerequisites

The course is primarily aimed at doctoral students. Eligibility: Admission to doctoral studies.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, doctoral students should be able to:

- describe and discuss research on subject-specific education
- define and use central approaches to and concepts from subject-specific education
- analyse and discuss research problems in subject-specific education

Course Content

The overall aim of the course is that doctoral students should acquire specialised knowledge on and familiarity with the subject-specific education research field and its central approaches and concepts. Doctoral students read central literature in the field covering different, interrelated research approaches to subject-specific education. Emphasis is placed on analysing and discussing research problems in subject-specific education that are relevant to doctoral students' own research projects.
