Hansun Zhang Waring is Associate Professor of Linguistics and Education at Teachers College, Columbia University and the founder of *The Language and Social Interaction Working Group* (LANSI). As an applied linguist and a conversation analyst, Hansun has primarily been interested in understanding the discourse of teaching and learning in a variety of pedagogical contexts. Her work has appeared in leading applied linguistics journals such as *Applied Linguistics*, *TESOL Quarterly*, *Language Learning*, and *The Modern Language Journal* as well as leading discourse journals such as *Research on Language and Social Interaction*, *Journal of Pragmatics*, *Text and Talk*, *Discourse Processes*, and *Discourse Studies*. She is the author of *Conversation Analysis and Second Language Pedagogy* (with Jean Wong; Routledge, 2010), *Theorizing Pedagogical Interaction: Insights from Conversation Analysis* (Routledge, 2016), and *Discourse Analysis: The Questions Discourse Analysts Ask and How they Answer them* (Routledge, 2018).
