

Abstract: The threats, risks and vulnerabilities of the cyber area are constantly increasing in both strength and scope. Sweden is one of the world's most digitized countries, but has also had major deficiencies in cyber security. This creates a risky combination of high dependency with major vulnerabilities. What consequences can this have for Sweden's security policy and what measures need to be taken to reduce risks and raise cyber security in Sweden?

Bio: Pål Jonson (M) is a Member of Parliament from Värmland and is active in the Justice Committee and the Defense Committee in charge of cyber security issues. He has previously worked as a security analyst at the Swedish Defense Research Institute FOI and as a political expert at the Ministry of Defense. He wrote his Ph.D. thesis on European Security Policy at the Department of War Studies at King's College London.
