Less formal travel tips from conference organisers

If you need to travel by plane, your best destination options are:

Stockholm (Arlanda airport). You have two options for reaching Karlstad from Arlanda:

- 1- There is a direct bus going from Arlanda to Karlstad's city centre several times a day. You can book your ticket here <https://www.nettbuss.se/#/> You can also buy your ticket upon arrival from the machines at the airport (though there is no guarantee that tickets would be available so late, so we recommend you to buy it in advance).

- 2- Take either the Arlanda Express train (a fast train that takes 18 min to Stockholm C – it goes every 10 to 15 min regularly and costs 195 sek if booked at least 7 days before the journey) <https://www.arlandaexpress.com> or the bus <https://www.flygbussarna.se> to Stockholm Central Station (the bus also goes regularly but takes about 40 min). You can buy your ticket (Arlanda Express as well as the bus) online and in advance or you can buy it at the airport from the machines.

From the Central Station you can take the train directly to Karlstad. You can buy the ticket via Swedish Railway website SJ: <https://www.sj.se/en/home.html>. The tickets could be bought in advance online or upon arrival at the station and from the machines (though there is no guarantee that tickets would be available so late, so we recommend you to buy it in advance).

Gothenburg (Landvetter airport). You need to get on the bus from the airport to Gothenburg Central Station. It takes about 20 min with the bus and the busses go every 10 to 15 min regularly. You can buy your ticket online <https://www.flygbussarna.se> or upon arrival at the airport from the machines. From Gothenburg Central Station you can take a direct train to Karlstad via SJ: <https://www.sj.se/en/home.html>. The tickets could be bought in advance online or upon arrival at the airport and from the machines (though there is no guarantee that tickets would be available so late, so we recommend you to buy it in advance).

There is no direct bus from Gothenburg to Karlstad so your best option is to travel via train.

Oslo. From Oslo Central Station you can take the bus directly to Karlstad via <https://shop.global.flixbus.com> OR <https://www.nettbuss.se>. Another option is to take the train from the central station via SJ: <https://www.sj.se/en/home.html>.

Tickets:

You can get a train ticket (for the entire journey, so including different train companies, e.g. both Arlanda Express + SJ combined) via SJ website: [https://www.sj.se/en/home.html/#/](https://www.sj.se/en/home.html#/)
Your starting point is "Arlanda C" and your destination "Karlstad C".

It is important to note that there are 3 options of SJ train tickets: non-rebookable (the cheapest); re-bookable (usually 100 SEK more expensive - but you can exchange it for a new ticket for the same destination); refundable (much more expensive - but can be just returned and refunded).

While Arlanda Express tickets can be used on any train on the date for which the ticket is issued, the SJ train ticket is valid only for the train it is bought for. Thus, sometimes it might be worth investing in a 're-bookable' version.

The seat reservation is included in the ticket price and you can choose your seat yourself – for instance, you can pick a 'quiet compartment' seat if you prefer to work or sleep and like to avoid unnecessary noise.

Furthermore, SJ tickets on certain routes in Sweden tend to get more expensive closer to the date of the travel - and even more so on so-called 'strategic' days of the week (that is, Friday and Sunday - as a lot of people commute). This is also why it might be wise to book your train travel in advance.

Dates of travel:

The conference starts at 8:00 on 4th November and finishes at 17:30 on 5th November, so please keep that in mind when planning your travels.
