ACADEMICS

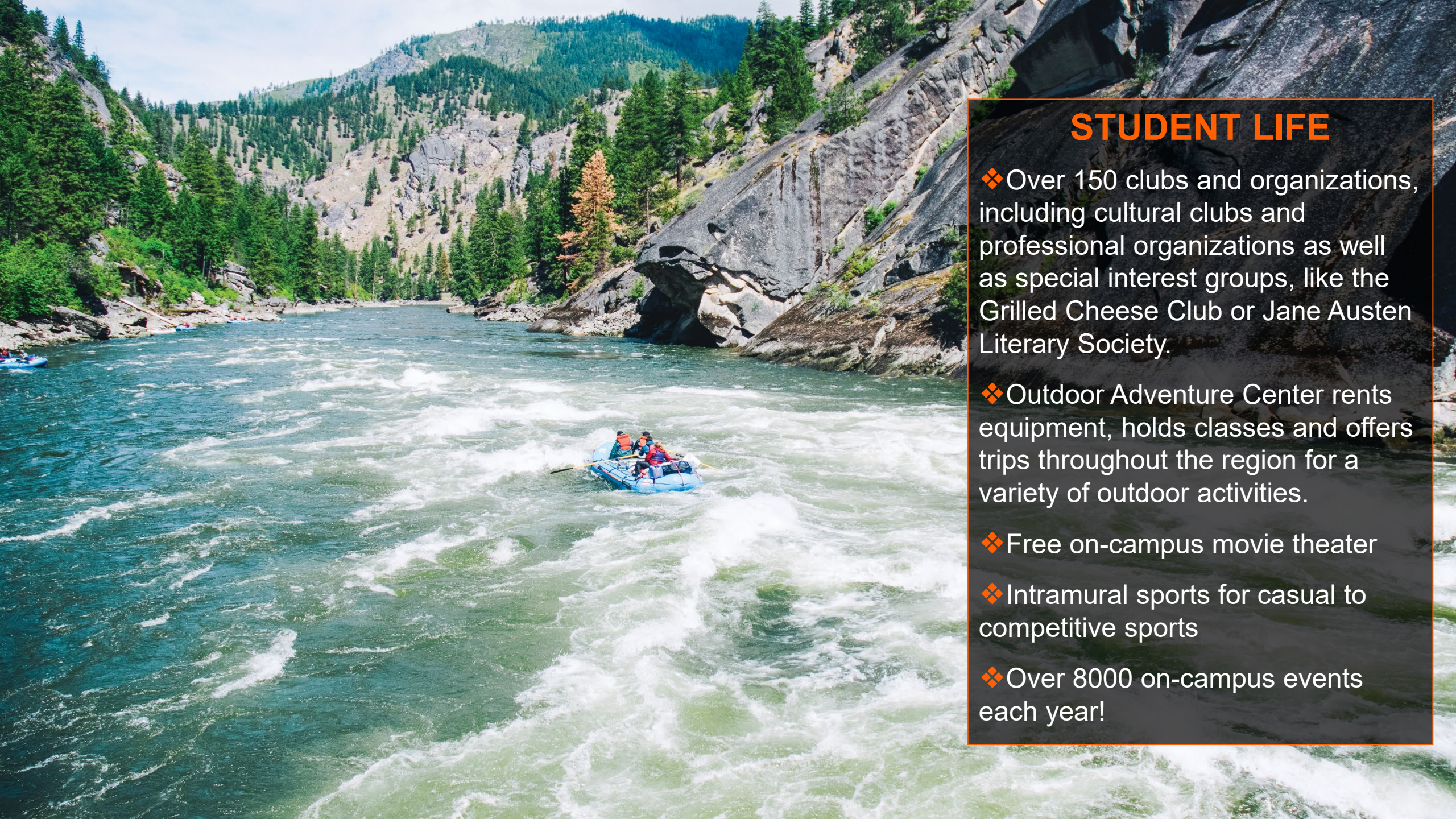
- ❖ Exchange students have the opportunity to choose classes from almost any of our 250 programs (exceptions include Nursing, Dental Hygiene and Pharmacy).

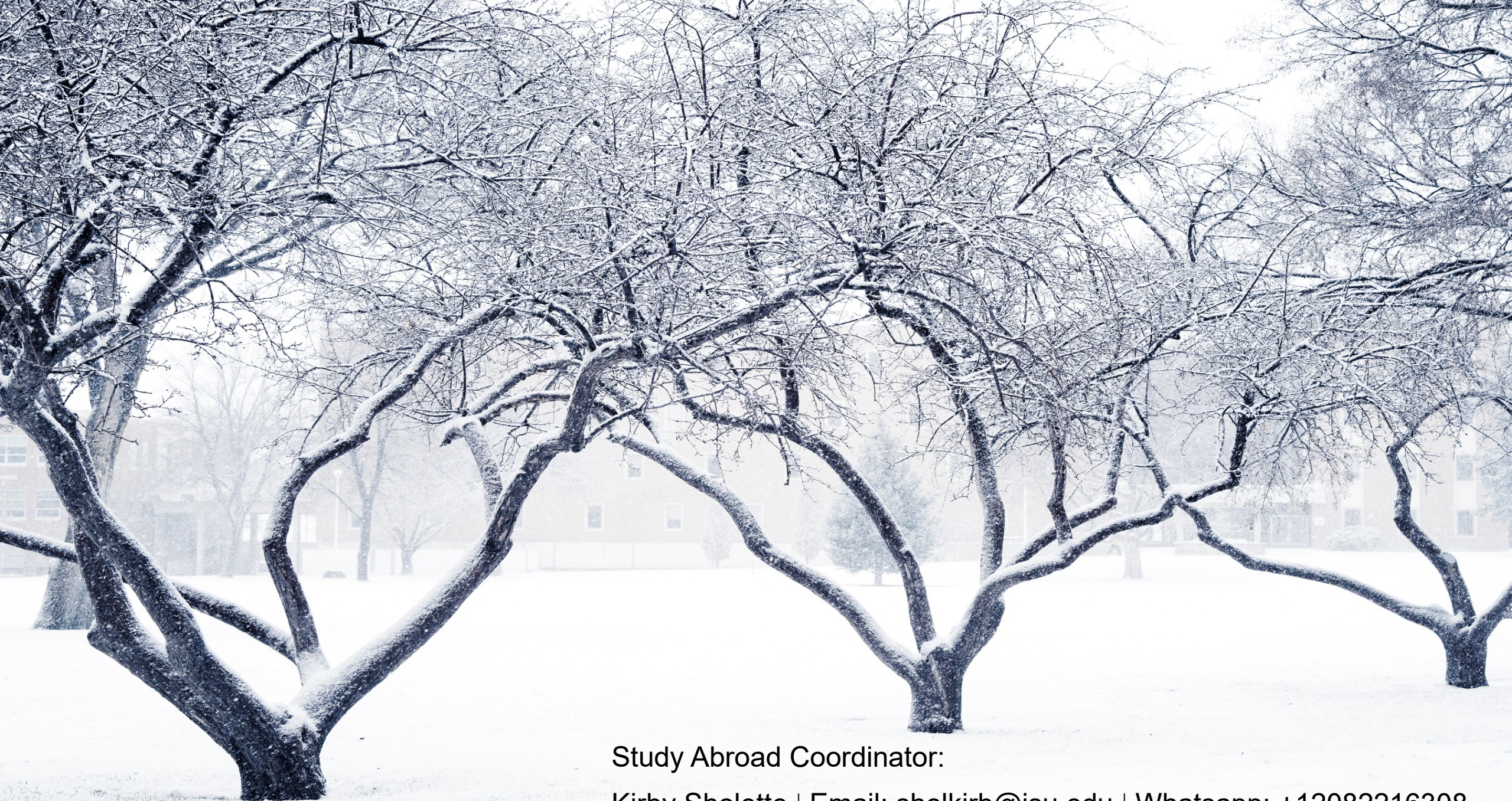
