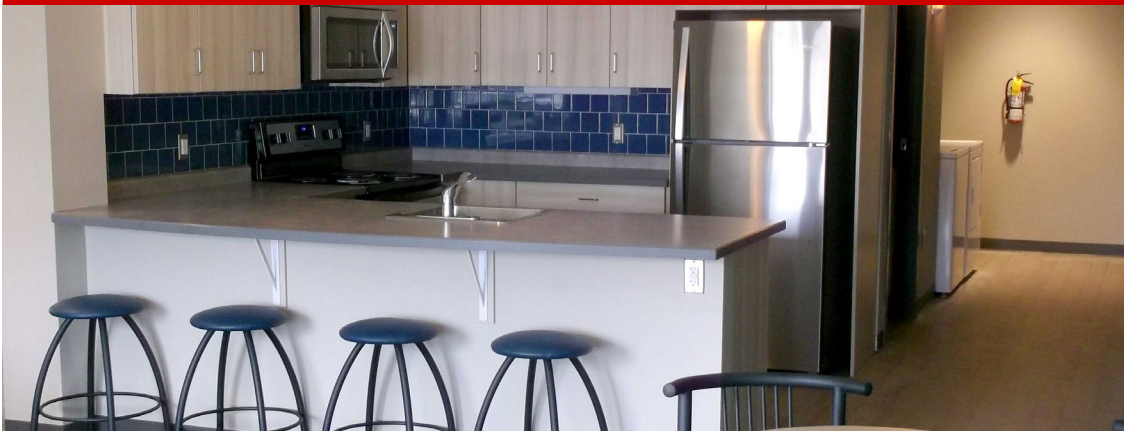

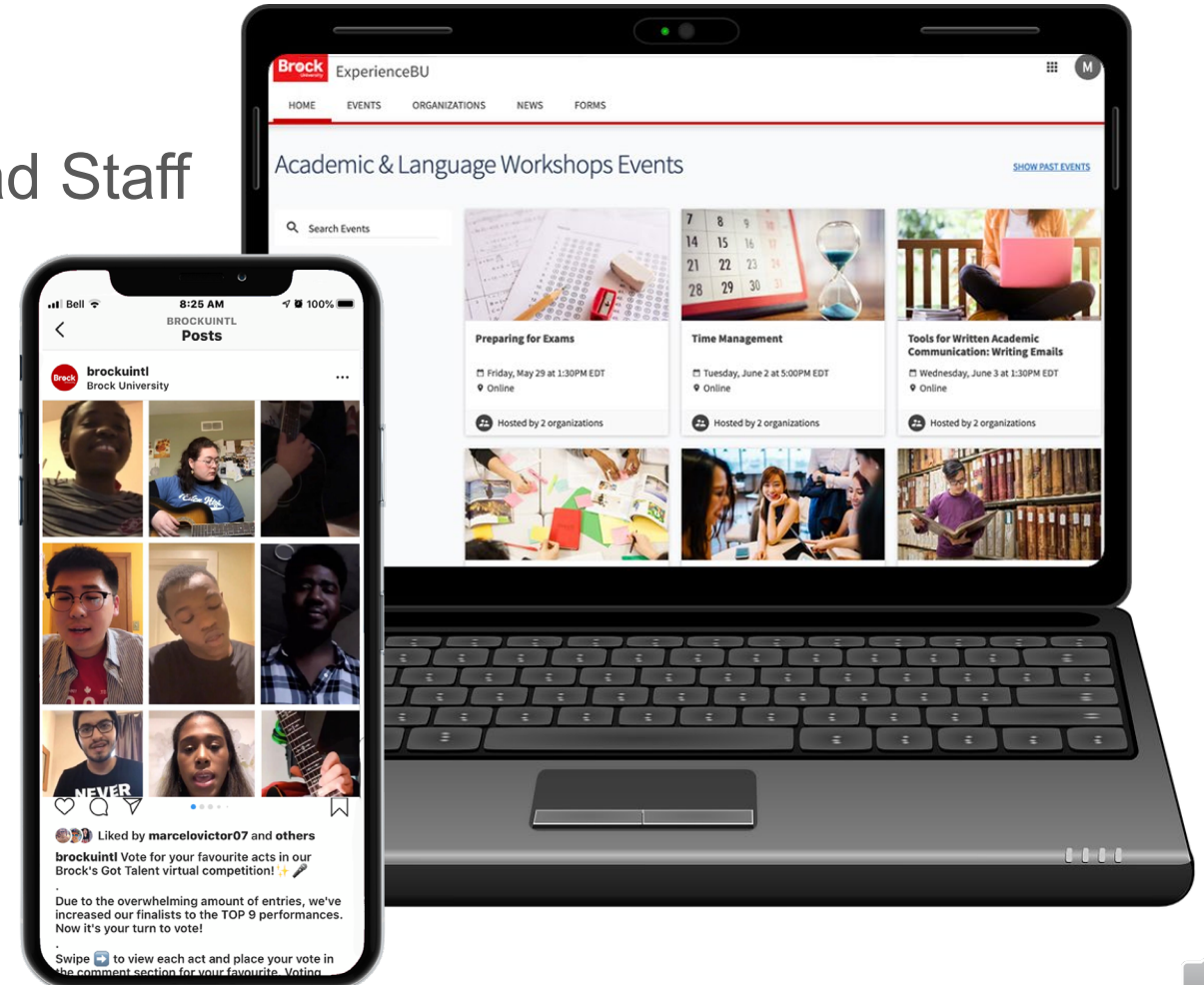

English is the primary language of instruction at Brock University. If your first language is not English you prove proficiency with one of the following:

IELTS	overall 6.5, no band below 6.0
TOEFL (destination code: 0895)	overall 88, with minimum 21 on speaking and 21 on writing
MELAB	overall 85, no other part under 80
CAEL	overall 70, no other band score under 60
PTE	58



'AT-HOME' ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TEST OPTIONS

In addition, we will also accept the TOEFL-at-Home Edition Test, which can be taken online.

For Spring and Fall 2020 applicants and Winter 2021 applicants only, Brock will also accept Duolingo, which requires a passing test score of 110.
