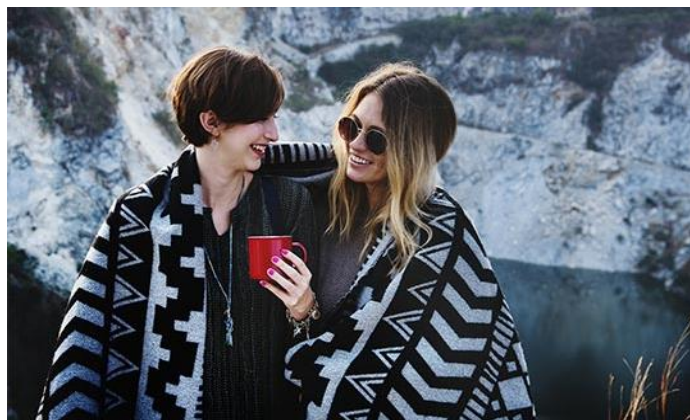

- What is it?

The Buddy Program helps international students to deal with language barriers and cultural differences, and establish social contacts while offering both international and French students an opportunity to have a multi-cultural college experience. French students interested in language and culture will be paired with an incoming international student and will help them settle into life in Lyon.

Health:

- Preventive medicine

Consultation and prevention (for any questions related to: vaccines, help with smoking cessation, sexual health or for an ad hoc medical opinion)

- Counselling service (Point écoute)

Emotional and psychological support provided by a professional in a confidential atmosphere

- Mission Handicap

The goal is to ensure a comfortable learning environment for students with disabilities. Specific procedures regarding courses or exams can be implemented, depending on the student's situation. For example, cognitive and physical troubles, health problems, temporary handicap (fracture...)



Accommodation service:

It helps students at UCLy look for accommodation. There are different types of housing: UCLy student residences, social housing, boarding house with families... Students can also be eligible for housing benefits (CAF).



Food services:

A cafeteria is located on each of the campuses (operated by the CROUS), where students can enjoy a hot lunch, salads, sandwiches, for very reasonable prices!



Culture:

- Choirs of UCLy and Studentt's Orchestra: students who desire to sing or play music can join the Concert choir or the Orchestra
- Theatre group: students can act in funny and short plays



The Chaplaincy

Students can meet our Chaplain in a few minutes in the reception room and participate in solidarity and creativity initiatives throughout the year.



Associations of UCLy:

- Fédé K'to: organises events during all the year (UCLy's ball, looking for an amazing talents...)
- Web radio Unisphère: a transversal association of UCLy, which gives the voice to students.
- The New locals: a sustainable development association, which fights for a responsible consumption, organic food and Zero waste.
- L'Apostrophe: UCLy's students newspaper. Daily posting of content through social networks and the website.



Music:

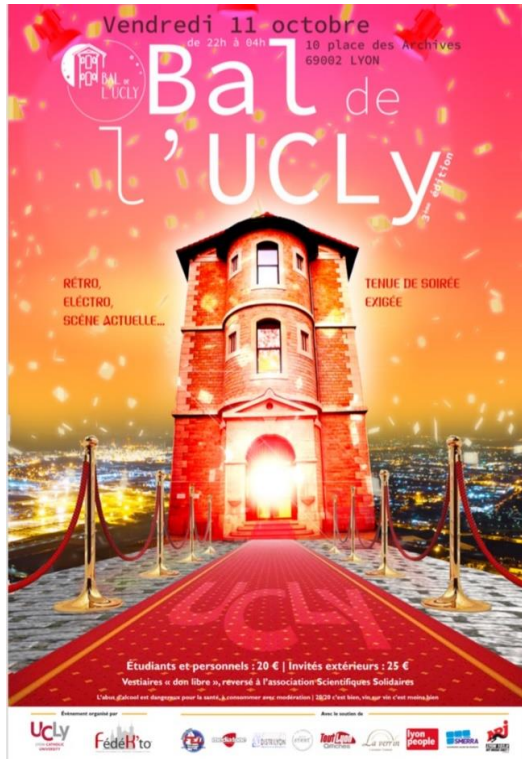
A space equipped with drums, a digital piano... is available to practice and meet other musicians.
