Target Group and Prerequisites

Admission to a doctoral programme.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, doctoral students should demonstrate

- that they can support the learning of others,
- knowledge of the opportunities and limitations of literary and language studies, and
- the ability to place their own research in a societal context.

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Course Content

By reading and reviewing texts written by other doctoral students and by discussing their own texts, the course aims to develop the ability of participants to contextualise their own research in a broader sense, both academically and societally.

Examination

Outcomes 1–2 are assessed through the presentation of own texts and the critical review of texts written by others in PhD seminars. Outcome 3 is assessed through an oral presentation, preferably in held English during the final year of the doctoral programme, in which doctoral students contextualise their research from a societal perspective.

One of the grades Fail (U) or Pass (G) is awarded in the examination of the course.
