Field intensives will run between June and August 2025.

Cost per unit is approx. AUD \$4,324.00 (includes accommodation during field trips). Subjects are delivered from CDU's Darwin or Alice Springs campuses. Travel to and from Darwin and Alice Springs is at students own expense.
